Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The multiplier event was organized and carried out by the partner CHRD/Commune de Lyon. It was spread over several activities in order to reach as broad a group of potential multipliers as possible. When selecting the participants, care was taken to ensure that they came from as many different contexts as possible, but generally had a close connection to topics such as resistance against National Socialism in their work and educational context.

On the three dates, different groups of students and educators were involved (fields: non-formal education, especially artistic field). First of all, they received an introduction of general information about the project and a presentation of the different educational materials (texts, biographies, website). During a short tour through the CHRD's permanent exhibition some of the biographies were thematized again (Dora Schaul, Jean Moulin, Charles de Gaulle, Jeannine Sontag, Tom Morel, Germaine Tillon, Marianne Cohn). Afterwards, this tour was followed by showing the participants how to work with the materials in the education sector. Here the RESIST project website with the digital exhibition of the biographies including the potential learning opportunities was briefly presented as well.

Each event lasted 2,5 hours. There was a productive exchange during the event on multinational collaboration and learning, the challenges and difficulties as well as the similarities and differences in national cultures of remembrance. The participants expressed their content with the created RESIST materials and agreed with its didactic approach. Especially the multimedia realisation of the RESIST materials were highly welcomed. The usability of the project results was discussed and confirmed from both perspectives, teacher and learners. The Multiplier Events are considered a success from all parties as they shed light on new materials and offered networking opportunities among all parties involved.
